



THE AMBITION OF THE STUDIO


Jamaica Becomes An English Colony


The island is taken over by the British during the Anglo-Spanish War.



PANORAMIC VIEW FROM STRAWBERRY HILL, ONE OF THE S. ANDREW'S MOUNTAINS, JAMAICA.

































